Students interested in Mock Trial should participate in the try-outs scheduled at the beginning of the fall semester. Moot Court (Appellate Advocacy) Teams requires concurrent or prior enrollment in Advanced Appellate Advocacy Seminar (DE 807). Enrollment must be approved by Professor Telfeyan.

The Registrar's Office will add units to student schedules after approval is granted by the Faculty or Team Advisor.

#### **Overview and Schedule**
