



Oak Park Neighborhood Scholarship

The Oak Park Neighborhood Scholarship is a full tuition only scholarship for a qualified full or part time JD student (maximum 88 units). The tuition only scholarship is renewable as long as the student is in good academic standing and remains a resident of Oak Park.

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must reside in the Oak Park neighborhood of Sacramento, CA and must be a resident of the Oak Park neighborhood for three continuous years prior to matriculation at University of the Pacific McGeorge School of Law. Applicants will be required to submit proof of residency. *(Applicants may qualify if the applicant was away at college and the Oak Park address is their primary address.)*

Applicants must meet all other JD application requirements and deadlines, as outlined on the [University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law](#) website, and must be admitted to the J.D. program.

For consideration, please submit the requisite information to mcgeorge@pacific.edu. The scholarship will be awarded on a first come, first service basis. One new scholarship will be awarded to an incoming student each academic year.
