

AUDITING CLASSES – Unclassified Students
Practitioners/Professionals

Any practitioner /professional who wishes to audit a class at Pacific McGeorge School of Law must submit an application and subsequently obtain approval from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, who in turn will contact the course professor for approval. The Associate Dean will then notify the practitioner /professional as to whether he/she will be allowed to audit. The application for unclassified students form can be found at the following link:

The applicant will then be invoiced by the law school's Business Office for the applicable fees. These fees must be paid in advance of the first day of class.

The tuition fee for practitioners/professionals is as follows:

Academic Year 2014-15: \$1,522 per unit

The tuition fee structure for McGeorge alums is as follows:

0-5 years in practice: 25% of the current per unit charge

6 years and beyond: 50% of the current per unit charge
