

The University of the Pacific, Sacramento Campus Public Safety Department is tasked with the responsibility of protecting the community and property of this campus. We greatly appreciate your support by immediately reporting anything suspicious. Listed below are the incidents and or crimes that occurred on campus during the month of August 2017.

1 Fire Alarm **3000 blk. 32nd St. – On Campus** **080717**

Public Safety responded to a fire alarm in a housing unit on campus. Upon arrival it was discovered the pull alarm had been hit on accident while moving furniture. Sacramento City Fire arrived and was advised of the accidental activation of the alarm. Report was taken.

2 Agency Assist / Weapons **33rd St. near Donner Way – Off Campus** **081217**

Public Safety observed two subjects in McClatchy Park who were having a loud argument. One of the subjects went to his parked vehicle, retrieved a weapon, placing it in his pocket and walked toward the other party. Public Safety notified Sacramento Police via radio and assisted in detaining the subject who was found to have a large knife in his pocket. The subject was arrested by Sacramento Police and transported to jail. Report was taken.

3 Medical Assist **3200 blk. Donner Way – On Campus** **081317**

Public Safety assisted with a campus visitor who was experiencing a medical issue. Sacramento Fire responded and transported the visitor to UC Davis for further evaluation. Report was taken.

4 Fire Alarm **3100 blk. Donner Way. – On Campus** **081617**

Public Safety responded to a fire alarm to a campus building. Upon arriving a slight smell of smoke could be detected in one of the restrooms. Sacramento Fire responded and checked the building for the source of the smoke; however no source for the odor of smoke could be located. Report was taken.

5 Trespass **3100 blk. Donner Way. – On Campus** **081617**

Public Safety responded to a report of a person acting suspiciously on campus. Upon making contact the person was determined to be experiencing a mental health issue. Sacramento Police responded to assist in transporting the person to a mental health facility. Report was taken.

6 Medical Assist **3200 blk. 5th Ave – On Campus** **083017**

Public Safety responded to a student who was experiencing a medical issue. Sacramento Fire responded and transported the student to the hospital for further evaluation. Report was taken.

Let's Get This Academic Year Started!

As the adjusting to the rigors of campus life begin for our campus community, we at Public Safety would like to provide everyone with information that may have been lost during the first few weeks of campus life:

- 1) Pacific Connect: If there were an emergency on or around the campus could Public Safety notify you or a loved one? We hope we can, however if you have not taken the time to log into Inside Pacific and complete the information, you or your identified person will not be notified of important and exclusive information from the University in the event of an event on or around the campus. - 2) Parking: The grace period for parking ended on Thursday, August 31, 2017. Effective September 1st, Public Safety will be enforcing the new academic year parking permits. This enforcement includes parking in the short term visitor parking stalls. Vehicles found to belong to campus community are not allowed to utilize visitor parking and will subject to receive citations. Sacramento Campus Director Faverty has issued a copy of the new parking policy to the campus community and a digital version will be available on the Sacramento campus web site soon.
- 3) Recreation Center Policy: The campus wide smoking policy is in effect which includes smoking around the pool area of the campus Rec Center (which prohibits smoking/vaping). There is a no glass policy in the Rec Center pool area. We want everyone to enjoy the Rec Center; however violations of these policies may result having Rec Center privileges suspended and a judicial review by the McGeorge Dean of Students and or the University Associate Dean of Students for the Sacramento Campus.
- 4) Amazon Deliveries: Amazon has become a very efficient retail and delivery website. A person can go online and have many items delivered in the same day! This efficient system comes with the occasional non-efficient delivery system. In many immediate delivery scenarios, Amazon utilizes various vendors outside of the normal delivery vendors. These vendors are not familiar with the campus and are not readily identifiable as Amazon contract employees.
- 5) Public Safety is working with the Campus Director and mail room staff to develop delivery protocols for amazon deliveries. Some packages are not being delivered to the purchaser; they are being left out in the open, outside of campus buildings, in bushes and other areas that do not ensure the safe delivery of the package. Amazon does offer lockers for safe delivery of packages (on the Amazon website search for Amazon Delivery Lockers to locate the nearest locker to your location). FedEx, USPS, and UPS are familiar with campus and deliver their packages to the mail room on campus.
- 6) Residential Halls: We ask that you do not let unknown persons into the housing units. If the person has a lawful business and needs to gain entrance, please have them contact Public Safety's number of **(916) 739-7200**. We are happy to assist the person requesting entrance. Be mindful of leaving patio doors and windows open while you are attending classes, off campus, or sleeping. Campus safety begins with each member of our community.

Please be mindful of leaving items of value in plain sight in your parked vehicles. It only takes a second for a thief to break a window, grab the item and be gone. While we are on campus 24/7 we cannot be everywhere. We need your help! If you see someone (or persons) who may be suspicious, please call our number at **(916) 739-7200**. If you feel it is an emergency, you can dial 911; however there may be a delay in Sacramento PD contacting us.
