1 False Fire Alarm **2300 Block 5th Ave. – On Campus** **10/02/17**

Public Safety responded to a fire alarm activation in the Library. Upon securing the building it was determined the alarm was false due to a sensor malfunction. Sacramento Fire responded and cleared. Report was taken.

2 Petty Theft **3100 Block Donner Way - On Campus** **10/04/17**

A student reported a University owned bicycle had been removed from where it was parked to Public Safety. The bicycle could not be located and a theft report was taken.

3 Traffic Collision – Non Injury **3100 Block Donner Way - On Campus** **10/05/17**

Public Safety responded to a collision between a refuse truck and a vehicle parked in Lot 4. There were no injuries and a report was taken.

4 Disturbance **33rd St and Donner Way – On Campus** **10/11/17**

Public Safety responded to a report of a disturbance between a student and non-campus member in parking Lot 4. Public Safety was able to contact the involved non-campus member on 33rd St. at Montgomery. It was determined this person had been riding their bicycle and was cut-off by a student driving onto campus. The student was contacted by Public Safety to obtain their information regarding the incident. No one was injured. Report was taken.

5 Traffic Collision – Non Injury **3200 Block Donner Way – On Campus** **10/16/17**

Public Safety responded to a report by a student who claimed damage to their parked vehicle by another student's parked vehicle in parking Lot 3. Report was taken.

7 Vandalism **2900 Block 33rd St. – On Campus** **10/25/17**

While on patrol, Public Safety discovered graffiti had been sprayed on the university warehouse wall. Facilities was contacted to remediate the graffiti. Report was taken.

6 Suspicious Person **5th Ave. Bridge – Off Campus** **10/24/17**

Public Safety was contacted by a student who reported a suspicious person had followed the student and attempted to make contact with the student on the 5th Ave. Bridge. Public Safety searched the area for the person and vehicle with negative results. A report was taken and a campus-wide warning notice was issued.
