1 Trespass **33rd St at 5th Avenue - On Campus** **03/01/18**

Public Safety responded to suspicious persons in the Library. Public Safety contacted the two individuals (one was a previous campus member). Based upon the circumstances a Notice of Trespass was issued and both individuals left the campus. Report was taken.

2 Suspicious Activity **3000 Block 5th Avenue - On Campus** **03/02/18**

Public Safety responded to several dating flyers being posted throughout the campus and in the restrooms. Contact was made with the responsible persons who were advised of the requirements of posting flyers on campus. Report was taken.

Upon arrival Public Safety found a woman who had been driving her vehicle was lying partially on the street with part of her body in the vehicle and was in cardiac arrest. Sacramento fire and medical teams quickly responded and transported the patient to UC Davis Medical Hospital. Report was taken.
